

# *Frequently Asked Questions*



**Below are some of the most common questions people ask related to Town services and procedures:**

**What are your hours of operation?** 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. Monday through Friday.

**How do I pay for my Town Bill?** You can pay online, by mail, drop box or coming in to Town Hall. Do not place cash in the drop box please.

**What is included in my Town Bill?** You are billed for water, sewer and garbage services.

**Do I need a Business License to sell products as a seasonal peddler?** Yes. Restrictions apply.

**Do I need a Business License to do work in the Town?** Yes. Anyone doing work in the Town needs to obtain a Business License before they can do the work.

**Can I place a mobile home on my property?** The home must not be more than 15 years old. You need to ask the Zoning Administrator if the lot you want to place it on is zoned for mobile homes. You will need to apply for a Permit from the Town. If it is approved then you take the approved application to the Hampton County Building Department and they will issue you the permit.



**Can I cut down trees and clear my land?** Not without Town approval. Most trees are protected in the Town of Estill and if taken down must be replaced. There are some exceptions though. Check with the Zoning Administrator first. You will need a Permit Application approved first.

**How do I pay for a ticket?** You can pay online, by mail, drop box or coming in to Town Hall. Do not place cash in the drop box please.

**Do I need a demolition permit if I want to take down a building?** Yes. A Permit application must be approved by the Town. If it is approved then you take the approved application to the Hampton County Building Department and they will issue you the permit.

**Does the Town pick up furniture or appliances?** No the Town does not.

**Is there an event venue I can rent for a party or wedding?** Yes. The Bull Durham Center is available for rental for such events. Contact the Recreation Director at Town Hall 803-625-3243 for more information.

**What is the length of limbs should be to have them picked up?** Limbs may be in a pile no higher than 3-feet tall. Leaves must be bagged. Limb sizes also matter. Call Town Hall for details.
