# Estill Messenger

## Grant Awarded to the Town

The Town of Estill was awarded a Community Development Block Grant in the amount of \$750,000 for Phase II of the water system improvements in our Capital Improvement Plan. The project involves the installation of approximately 2,250 Linear Feet of 6 inch water line, adding 4 hydrants, reconnecting services, and installing radio read meters.

The area that has been identified will involve the installation of a 6 inch water main along portions of Hendrix Mill Road, Marvin Street, Owens Street, Hattie Street, Roberts Street, Newell Street, Lafittee Street, Washington Lane, Roosevelt Lane, Lincoln Avenue, Hoover Avenue, Martin Avenue and Kennedy Street where the current galvanized pipe will be removed.



The project is estimated to be completed in 24 months. The Town of Estill is committed to continuing to seek additional grant funding for more improvements to its water system.

- 1- Fill out a Building Permit Zoning Application with the Town.
- 2- Once it is approved by the Zoning Administrator, take the Application to Hampton County Building Department and they will issue you an actual Building Permit.

*(The County may have additional requirements)*

- 3- Contractors MUST have a Town Business License
